Would it not be better if we were to treat the economy as something made and remade by people themselves, rather than as an impersonal machine? The object of a human economy is the reproduction of human beings and of whatever sustains life in general. Such an economy would express human variety in its local particulars as well as the interests of all humanity. The editors have assembled here a citizen's guide to building a human economy. Résumé Abstract/Resumen	<i>(abstract excerpted from the article)</i> “Ron Stanfield has had a long and distinguished career as a social economist and commentator on the social economy. Of special concern to us in this article are Stanfield's interests in social capital, sustainable development, and nurturance which we refer to as caring. We also take up several other virtues including sympathy, benevolence, and generosity that have been part of the economics literature from the time of Smith's Moral Sentiments along with the associated vices of heartlessness, insensitivity, meanness, greediness, and others. This article attempts to show that (1) adding social capital to the machine-like individual of mainstream economics results in the acting person of personalist economics who becomes more fully a human person through social interactions that foster the development of several virtues or less fully a human person through other interactions that instill certain vices; and that (2) in matters relating to sustainability, becoming more fully a human person calls especially for the practice of the virtues of justice and moderation. In addition we have suggested a framework for thinking about sustainable development in terms of actuating and limiting principles and for developing critical values or performance standards for sustainable development that are person-centered.”

Résumé <i>Abstract/Resumen</i>	<i>(abstract excerpted from the article)</i> “A large vibrant nonprofit sector is often equated with a civically active and democratically inclined population. Yet, the degree to which different interests and needs are equally activated in a community’s nonprofit sector remains unclear. This article argues that more than the number of nonprofit organizations, the distribution of organizations across nonprofit fields can better represent the plurality of the nonprofit sector and its relationship to democracy. If the sector represents a permeable sphere for the activation of interests through formal voluntary action, one should see a more even nonprofit landscape in communities where there is greater population heterogeneity. Using national data on nonprofit organizations to investigate the determinants of nonprofit heterogeneity in U.S. counties, findings indicate that the nonprofit sector is semipermeable. Although greater population heterogeneity does lead to a more evenly distributed nonprofit sector, resource dependency and resource inequality complicate this relationship.”

Résumé Abstract/Resumen	<i>(abstract excerpted from the article)</i> "This article examines the social and financial performance of an international sample of non-governmental organizations (NGOs) which transformed into microfinance institutions (TMFI). It shows that recent calls for the transformation of NGOs into TMFIs help improve the financial sustainability and the breadth of outreach of microfinance activities. However, this transformation hinders the depth of the services provided by TMFIs. This is especially significant in the case of bank-TMFIs and suggests that although the transformation might increase the financial independence of TMFIs, it might cause a mission drift that both NGOs and policy-makers ought to consider."

Résumé Abstract/Resumen	<i>(abstract excerpted from the article)</i> "NGOs have, of late, found some of their traditional domains, such as provision of micro-credit and participatory development, coinciding with or being taken away by the state. How do they position themselves and retain relevance vis-a-vis the state in the changed scenario? Tracing the trajectory of interventions of a local NGO in Kerala, India, this article shows that NGOs exhibit 'multiple identities'—selective collaboration, gap-filling and posing alternatives—in the process of engagement with the state. Résumé <i>Abstract/Resumen</i>	<i>(abstract excerpted from the article)</i> "The nonprofit sector is confronting a potential leadership deficit and mounting pressures to become more efficient and businesslike. To begin to assess how these tensions influence pathways to leadership, this study investigates the professional backgrounds and nonprofit experience of leaders in the sector. Analysis demonstrates that some leaders have management credentials and management experience, but many advance in the nonprofit sector through substantive experience alone. Even though some nonprofit executives have spent most of their careers in the public sector or the business sector, the study also demonstrates that a nonprofit ethic matters a great deal for leadership. These findings suggest that substantive experience and dedication to the nonprofit sector constitute primary pathways to leadership in the sector, raising many questions about the role of management expertise and the evolution of leadership in the sector."

How do third sector organizations (TSOs) cope with turbulent environments? How they manage to adapt to the restructuring of welfare states and the expansion of markets is investigated in five European countries focusing on the policy fields of sports, culture and social services. Despite significant differences across countries and policy fields, the volume sheds light on a strong trend towards polarization within the third sector. There is indeed a blossoming of grassroots organizations strengthening local cohesion, but these organizations lack any lobbying power. At the same time, powerful notfor-profit organizations, heavily engaged in service provision, have emerged that work on par with commercial and public institutions. These businesslike organizations, however, are detached from any membership base, no longer providing avenues for societal integration."

Résumé <i>Abstract/Resumen</i>	<i>(resumen proveniente del artículo)</i> "Con una aproximación teórica a la innovación y a las empresas sociales, se analizan algunas de las experiencias relevantes surgidas en la empresa social; con ello se busca establecer si la empresa social puede ser considerada como una forma de organización innovadora. Las experiencias en el mundo toman forma a partir de las aportaciones surgidas durante el siglo XIX; siendo las ideas de Robert Owen el punto de partida para la conformación de la primera cooperativa de consumo, la que fue integrada por hombres emprendedores a los que se les conoció como los Pioneros de Rochdale. Poco tiempo después, surgen las cajas de ahorro establecidas por Friedrich Wilhelm Raiffeisen y Hermann Schulze-Delitzsch en Alemania. Durante el siglo XX son ubicadas en Canadá dos experiencias relevantes: el movimiento de Antigonish y las cooperativas de ahorro y crédito Desjardins. Igualmente, en España surge la importante experiencia de las empresas de Mondragón. Emprendimientos más recientes surgen en Brasil con las incubadoras tecnológicas de cooperativas; en Bangladesh destacan las empresas sociales de Yunus; en Argentina y Uruguay se ubica a las empresas recuperadas y en México las cooperativas de producción y de ahorro y crédito. Se concluye que en sí mismas las empresas sociales son ejemplo de innovación, creando valor económico y valor social para sus socios y las comunidades en donde se desarrollan. Además de que en diferentes épocas, con su conformación se ha contribuido a la solución de problemáticas comunes que han aquejado a diversos sectores de la población en el mundo."

Private government has two distinct elements comprised of the interests of businesses and nonprofit organizations that exercise power to interact with government to achieve their specific goals and objectives. This new, yet familiar, lens on which to consider the role of the nonprofit sector in the United States and the manner in which it interacts with government policy makers and business decision makers adds clarity to the muddle of terminology scholars have assembled to classify and characterize one of American society's most distinguishing features. The article will be of interest to domestic and international scholars seeking yet another tool to compare nongovernmental organizations and the particular character of civil society in countries that do not have the same political traditions as the United States."

Este fenómeno no ha hecho más que incrementarse más recientemente con la problemática social abierta tras la implementación de las políticas neoliberales en la región y el mundo y los nuevos desafíos impuestos por la globalización. Résumé <i>Abstract/Resumen</i>	<i>(abstract excerpted from the article)</i> "This bibliography is an attempt to list the most relevant material on the topic of 'social entrepreneurship' published within the past two decades. The Academic Search Complete and Web of Science databases were used to conduct a literature search using the keywords 'social enterprise', 'social entrepreneurship' and 'social entrepreneur'. The literature search was limited to peer-reviewed journal articles and books published between 1989 and 2009. Since academic interest in social entrepreneurship is a relatively new phenomenon, very little research in this area was conducted before 1989. Two seminal pre-1989 articles were included in this list: Banks (1972), who first coined the term 'social entrepreneur' in the context of the sociology of social movements; and Drucker (1979), who first introduced the concept of 'social enterprise' while advocating ethical responsibilities of corporations. Only articles and books in which 'social entrepreneurship', 'social enterprises' or 'social entrepreneurs' were the main focus and had an important role in either the formulation of an empirical study or the development of a conceptual framework were included in this list. Articles that merely mentioned these terms or in which these concepts did not play a major role were not included. Mention may be made of online resources, such as technical reports, unpublished manuscripts, conference papers and white papers. All but two such articles, Dees (2001) and Alter (2004), were excluded from this list. The article by Dees (2001) titled, 'The meaning of "social entrepreneurship"', is a significant conceptual contribution to the field and has been cited 211 times since its publication online. Alter's article (2004) that presents a typology of social enterprises is yet another important theoretical contribution and has been cited 35 times since it was published online. It is hoped that this systematic and thorough listing of relevant work in the area of social entrepreneurship will be of assistance to scholars in a field in which the literature, to date, has been fragmented and disjointed. It will be much appreciated if the unintentional omission of any relevant articles and books is brought to the attention of the author."
